AIFRUCTO/ 2023- 001 dated 11-01- 20023 and representation

No. AIFRUCTO/ 2024-001 dated 04-04-2024, regarding the demands of Retired University and College Teachers' of the country. The following issues were raised for your kind

intervention:

1. Fixation of pension of retired Associate Professors of colleges in Professor scale. Since the post of professor has been given by the UGC in its 7th Pay Revision to Colleges and Associate Professors are being promoted as Professors, the pension of retired Associate Professors should also be fixed in the Professor scale.
2. 6th CPC has recommended payment of 20% additional quantum of pension for pensioners above 80 years of age w.e.f. Jan 2006. Some states have awarded an additional quantum of pension to pensioners aged 75 years 15%, 10% at 70 years and 5% to pensioners aged 65 years. We demand that this scheme should be implemented uniformly across the country.
3. One notional increment should be given to those who retire from the service on June 30, since the date of increment falls on the

next day of retirement i.e. 1st July. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has already established law in the case Union of India vs. P. Ayyamperumal R. P. (c) No. 1731/2019 in SLP (C) No. 22008/2018.

4. The commutation period of pension should be reduced from the current 15 years to 10 years throughout the country due to a drastic decrease in the interest rates.
5. Senior pensioners of Universities and Colleges should also be given the benefit of a 20% additional quantum of pension from the first day of the calendar month in which it falls due and not from the date of completion of 80 years of age.
6. We request the Govt. of India to formulate a 'Medical Scheme' for university and college retired teachers that will help them to get lifesaving treatment.
7. Our organisation requests the Govt. of India to implement the 7th UGC Pay Scale and pension based on the concordance table without any modification to all retired university and college teachers in all states and union territories.
8. We request the Govt. of India to give some sort of relief to all pensioners in the payment of income tax. Either the slabs of income tax should be modified or the ceiling amount should be increased.
9. We demand a uniform pension scheme for all retired university and college teachers in all states and union territories. There are still some states where pensions are not being paid to university and college retired teachers. For instance, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh and some Northeastern states like Manipur, and

8. We request the Govt. of India to give some sort of relief to all pensioners in the payment of income tax. Either the slabs of income tax should be modified or the ceiling amount should be increased.
9. We demand a uniform pension scheme for all retired university and college teachers in all states and union territories. There are still some states where pensions are not being paid to university and college retired teachers. For instance, Punjab, Himachal Pradesh and some Northeastern states like Manipur, and







1. Heard Sri Pradeep Agrawal, learned counsel assisted by Sri Alok Gupta, learned Advocate for the petitioners and Sri Jogendra Nath Verma, learned Standing Counsel for the State.

2. By means of this writ petition, the petitioners have prayed for the following reliefs:-

"(a) to issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of certiorari quashing the provisions stating restoration period as 15 years in the Uttar Pradesh Civil Pension (Commutation) Rules, 1941 as amended by G.O. No.Sa.3-1508/10-2008-308-97 dated 08.12.2008 issued by the Finance (General) Section-3 of State of Uttar Pradesh, contained in Annexure Nos.2 and 3 to this writ petition, after summoning the records.

(b) to issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus for restoration of the commuted pension after expiry of 10 years 11 months or at best 11 years instead of 15 years as provided in the G.O. dated 08.12.2008.

(c) to issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the opposite parties not to deduct the amount of commuted portion of pension from the monthly pension after the expiration of 10 years 11 months or at best 11 years during the pendency of this writ petition before this Hon'ble Court.

(d) to issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus to refund the excess amount of money it recovered from the pension with regard to the commuted amount relating to the petitioners."

3. All the petitioners are retired Doctors from the Medical Department and more than 10 years period have expired since their retirement. The petitioners are aggrieved of inaction on the part of the opposite parties by deducting the amount from monthly pension for a period of 180 months (15 years) whereas the commutation amount paid at the time of retirement and the interest thereon is fully recovered in a period of 131 months (10 years and 11 months) or at best 11 years.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that the manner under which the amount of recovery has been proposed is patently illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory and uncalled for. The aforesaid amount is being recovered from the Doctors/ petitioners from the date of their retirement.

5. Sri Agarwal has stated that such grievance has been noticed by the various High Courts e.g. Kerala High Court and Punjab and Haryana High Court and granted some interim protection, and as such, the petitioners filed this writ petition.

6. Attention has been drawn towards Annexure No.6 of the writ petition which is an interim order dated 09.02.2024 passed by the High Court of Punjab and Haryana in the case bearing CWP No.2490 of 2024; Ram Saroop Jinda vs. State of Punjab and others. As per Sri Agarwal, the aforesaid issue is identical with the issue of the present petitioners.

7. Since the recovery is being executed from the retired employees since their date of retirement and as per learned counsel for the petitioners such recovery is patently illegal and arbitrary, therefore, it appears that cause of action is recurring in nature, hence, a detailed and exhaustive counter affidavit would be required from the opposite parties.

8. Learned Standing Counsel prays for and is granted three weeks time to file a detailed counter affidavit.

9. List this case on 22.08.2024.

10. Till the next date of listing, no further recovery shall be executed from the petitioners. However, it is made clear that this interim protection may be extended on the next date only after hearing of learned counsel for the parties.

In compliance to Interim Order passed by Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in various CWPs, the necessary directions to stop the recovery of Commuted Value of Pension till the vacation of stay orders, from Pensioners (Petitioners in CWPs) who has completed 10 years of retirement or above have already been issued to your offices.

3. In order to avoid further litigation in the matter, State Government has considered the issue and decided **to stop the recovery of Commuted Value of Pension till the vacation of Stay Orders, from all Pensioners (including Petitioners) of State Government who has completed 10 years of retirement or above.**

You are requested to issue necessary directions to the officers concerned for implementation of above decision.

Subject :- Implementation of judgment dated 09.04.2024 passed by Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High court in LPA 696 of 2022 in CWP 16353 of 2020- Malagar Singh Vs State of Punjab and others - Regarding grant of notional annual increment after retirement .

Sir/Madam,

This is in reference to the earlier instruction no. FD-FP-206(PYFG)/3/2020-1FP2/86 dated 18-03-2021 issued by Department of Finance, in which it was clarified that no increase can be allowed in the pay of Government employee after the day he/ she ceases to be a Government employee. It was also conveyed that his/ her pension cannot be calculated on any pay which is more than the last pay drawn.

2. Now, the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in its judgment passed in LPA 696 of 2022 in CWP 16353 of 2020 - Malagar Singh Vs State of Punjab and others dated 09.04.2024, has dismissed the Appeal of the State confirming the judgment passed in CWP 32598 of 2019 titled as Gurdev Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another (bunch matters) and has allowed the release of benefit of notional annual increment after retirement for the purpose of pensionary benefits.

The extract of order in CWP No. 32598 of 2019 dated 16.03.2022 is reproduced as under:-

"..... The respondents are directed to grant the petitioners the benefit of one notional increment so as to fix their last drawn pay at the time of their retirement and their pensionary benefits be re-calculated on the basis of said last drawn pay but petitioners, as undertaken by them will not be entitled for the arrears up to the date of filing their respective petitions by them and the actual benefits of arrears upon re-fixation of their pension will be given to the petitioners from the date of filing of the writ petitions. The petitioners are held not entitled for any arrears prior to the date of filing of the writ petitions by the petitioners as agreed by them before this Court at the time of hearing. Let the re-fixation of the pensionary benefits upon revised last pay drawn be done by the respondents within a period of two months from the receipt of copy of this order and the actual arrears for which the petitioners become entitled for under this order be released to them within a period of one month thereafter."

3. The Government has therefore revisited these instructions as referred in para 1 above, and has now decided to grant the benefit of one notional annual increment to all the pensioners of the State Government who have completed 12 months of service on the date of their retirement for purpose of re-fixation of their last drawn pay for the purpose of computing their pensionary benefits. The increment shall, however, be granted if otherwise admissible as per provisions of Punjab Civil Services Rules i.e. subject to verification of service records.


4. As per directions of the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court as mentioned above, the arrears of pensionary benefits shall be payable to the petitioners only from the date of filing of their respective writ petitions.

5. The financial benefit / Arrears in cases of the pensioners (Non petitioners) shall be payable only from the date of issuance of these instructions.

6. The Finance Department shall separately decide on amendment in the relevant rules if so required.

7. All the Administrative Departments / pension sanctioning authorities are advised to implement the above instructions meticulously in its true letter and spirit.
